<u>RE:</u> 111 Rayette Road – Compliance and Reporting with the federal National Pollutant Release Inventory (NPRI), Ontario Toxics Reduction Act (TRA) and the Ontario Ministry of the Environment (O. Reg 127/01) reporting schemes

Dear Ms. Iozzo,

This is to inform you of the results of our audit of your facility at 111 Rayette Road, Concord, ON for compliance with the Federal National Pollutant Release Inventory (NPRI), the provincial Toxics Reduction Act (TRA) and the O. Reg 127/01 reporting schemes, with submission via Environment Canada's Single Window Information Manager (SWIM).

Based upon the information you have provided, our calculations indicate that you did not, in calendar year 2014, manufacture, process or otherwise use substances on the 2014 NPRI Part 1a, 1b, 2, and 3 tables in sufficient quantities to be reportable, nor did you emit NPRI Part 4 substances in sufficient quantities to be reportable.

Based on this assessment, you are not required, at this time, to report your emissions and usage amounts to NPRI and/or TRA for this facility.

In 2014, the 111 Rayette Road facility did not manufacture, process or otherwise use acetone, and thus, is not required to report to the MOE concerning O. Reg. 127/01.
